Esteban is a compassionate leader and visionary strategist who inspires organizers by drawing on science fiction and social theory for collective liberation. He serves on numerous local, regional, and national cooperative boards and previously worked at NASCO and the New Economy Coalition. Esteban Co-chairs the Philadelphia Food Policy Advisory Council, following 8 years as a worker-owner in Mariposa Food Co-op's Staff Collective.
