Monthly Meetings



FLOOR MEETING

Meet with the floor rep and other members of your floor to discuss co-op business and get to know neighbors.


COUNCIL MEETING

Elected council members meet to discuss co-op business and vote on management decisions. All members may observe.

GENERAL MEETING

All members are invited to discuss co-op business, vote on management decisions, hear reports and share ideas.

Co-op Council (elected annually)



Positions include other duties such as acting as leaders and communicating information with other members.



Your co-op also has a LIAISON/COORDINATOR, a CSI staff member who supports the co-op and acts as a bridge with management.
